✓ Areas of Use

- For outdoor use only.
- For use in drains, on concrete paths and patios, tarmac, garden canes, labels, secateurs, knives, water butts and greenhouses.
- Also suitable for use in stables, hutches, kennels and pigeon lofts.

✗ Where NOT to use

- Not for indoor use.



Directions For Use

- **Drains:** use neat in outdoor drains. This will disinfect as it cleans, removing germ laden grease and dirt. Rinse thoroughly. Use when necessary, particularly during hot spells.
- **Concrete paths and patios:** to kill mould, algae and fungi, dilute 150ml to every 5 litres of water. Apply sufficient solution to thoroughly wet the affected surfaces. Allow 30 minutes then rinse off with water and scrub with yard brush. For light coloured stones, dilute 50ml per 5 litres of water to avoid staining. Test a small area.
- **Tarmac areas:** to kill mould, algae and fungi and remove stains and mildew, dilute 125ml to 5 litres of water in a watering can. Apply sufficient solution to thoroughly wet the affected surfaces. Check a small area for softening first. If tarmac does soften, use a lower dilution of 60ml to 5 litres of water and repeat treatment after 1 month.
- **Canes, Labels, Secateurs & Knives:** to disinfect, wipe over with 10ml per litre of water. Leave for 5 minutes then rinse off.
- **Water Butts:** to prevent the build up of slime. To clean water butts, scrub with a solution of 15ml to 5 litres of water. To freshen water, add 5ml Jeyes Fluid to a full water butt.
- **Greenhouses:** remove all plants (cover over perennials, vines etc). Wash down all glass, glazing bars and shelving with 35ml per 5 litres of water. Ventilate and allow to dry before reintroducing plants. Jeyes Fluid may discolour paintwork and plastics. Test on a small area prior to use.

Health & Safety Precautions

- Harmful if in contact with skin and if swallowed.
